



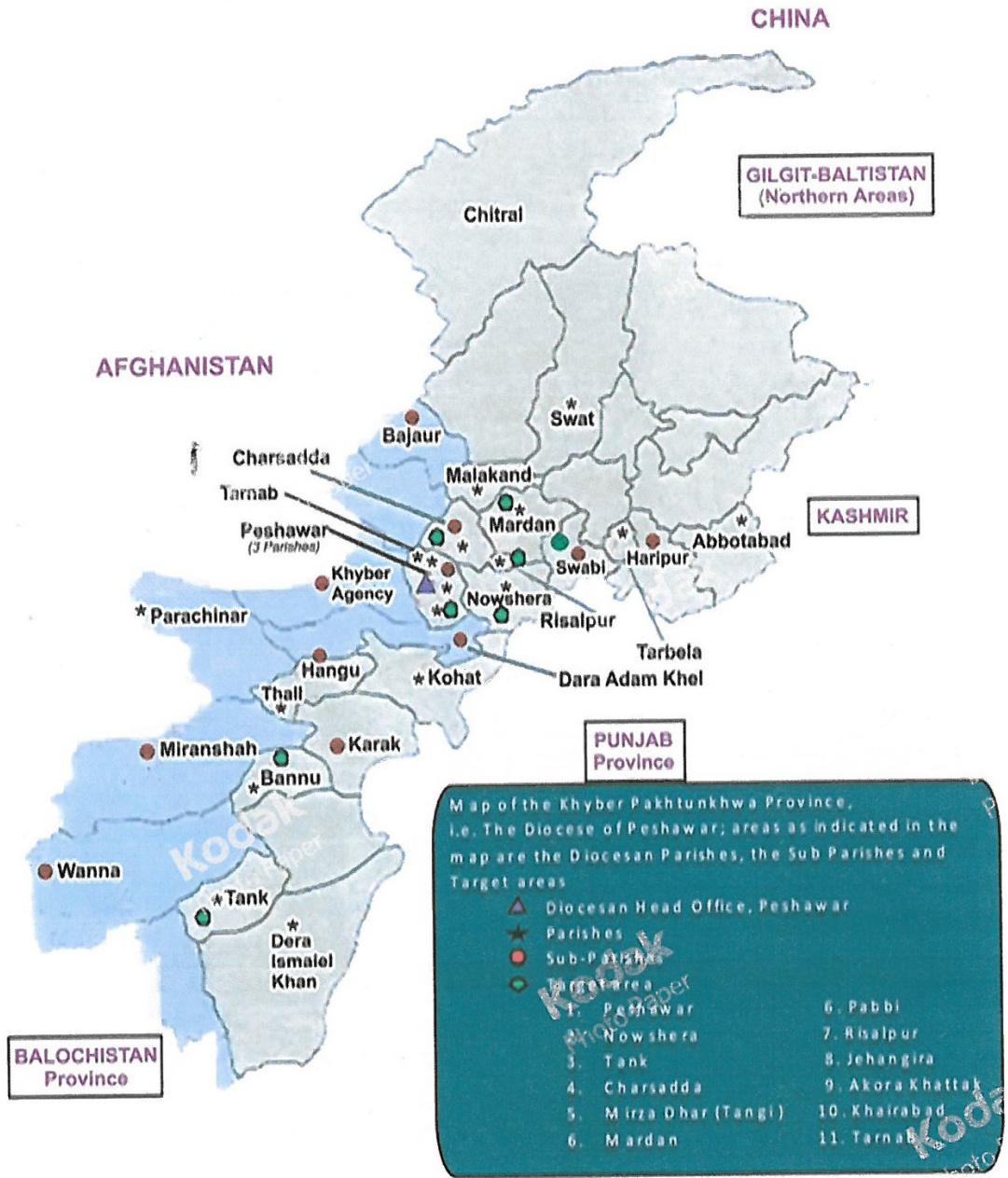

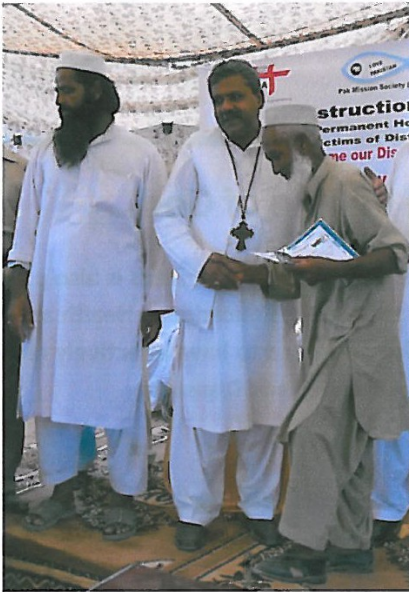

Partners in Mission mostly from the European and American countries before and after the Independence of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan in 1947 have played a significant role in sharing the Good News in our sub-continent. The Diocese of Peshawar, Church of Pakistan besides meetings the spiritual needs is also practically serving the people of the Khyber Pukhtunkhwa Province through its Educational, Health and Community Development Programmes. The Diocese is also privileged to have effectively responded to the needs of the affected people during the following Emergencies and Disasters:

- i- **Afghan Refugees crisis 1980 - onwards.**
- ii- **October 8, 2005 earthquake victims (still supporting with Health & Education)**
- iii- **December 2007 Food Supplies to the war affected people of Hangu, Parachinar**
- iv- **August 2007 Flood affected victims of Mardan**
- v- **2008 Internally Displaced People of Swat Valley**
- vi- **2010 Support towards flood affected people of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**

The Diocese of Peshawar believes that a better society based on principles of peaceful co-existence, non-violence, justice, equality, and human rights is possible provided the local and the International Church i.e. the whole Body of Christ join hands together.

Diocese Mission: "To spread the knowledge of the Gospel, to provide pastoral care, and also to be an instrument of service and witness to the whole people of God."

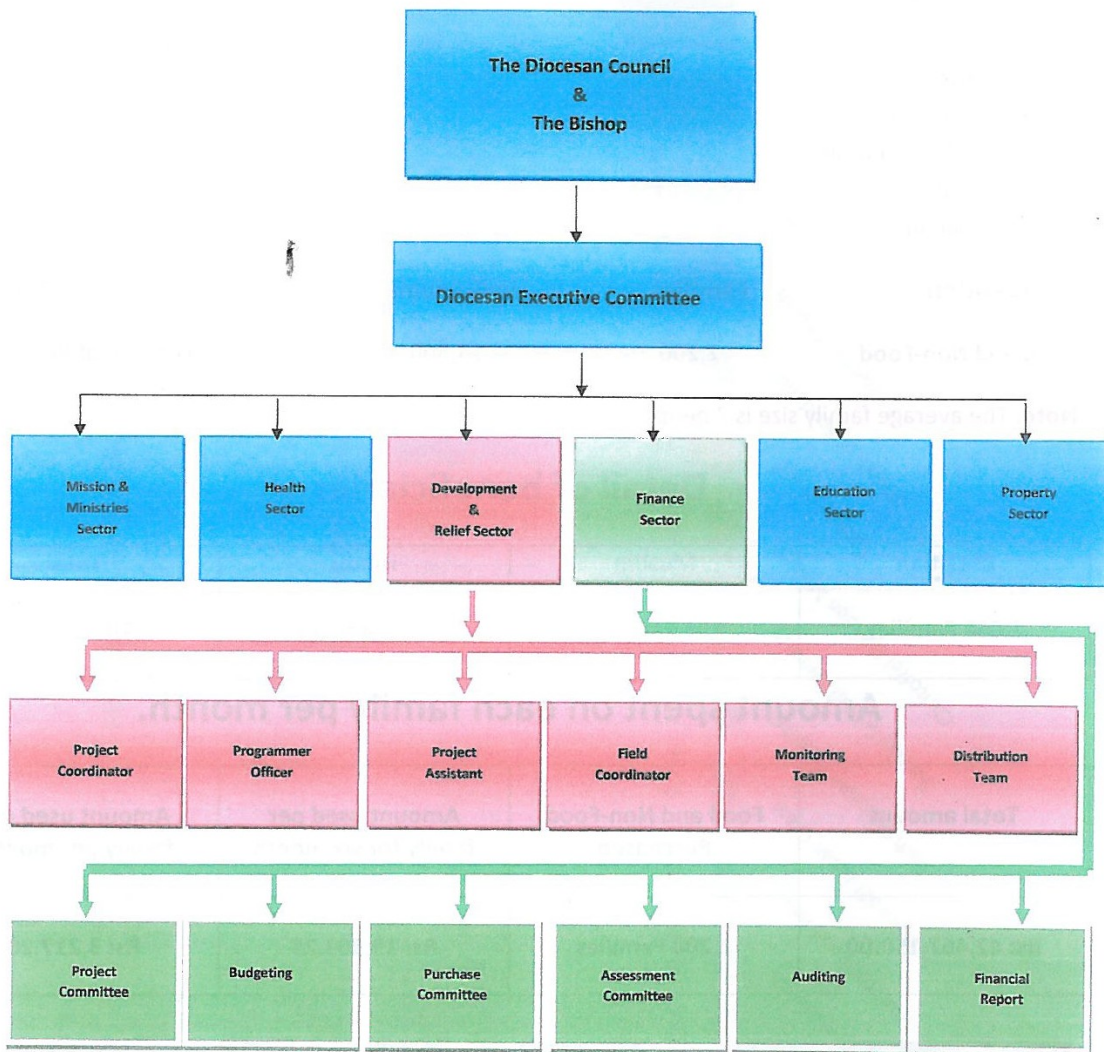
Besides spiritual responsibilities the Diocese stands for the socio-economic empowerment of the poor and the marginalized to enable them to lead a dignified life. The Diocese has always supported the local communities in the times of emergencies and disasters irrespective of creed, colour or ethnicity. The areas where no NGO can enter, Diocese being a local entity has no problem of accessibility. During the floods of 2010 the Diocese helped 2,200 flood affected families in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province in the following areas:

Nowshera - Peshawar - Tank – Risalpur - Charsadda - Bannu – Mirza Dhar

The Diocese with the kind financial support of International Churches and Partners provided Food, Non-Food items and hygiene kits to 2,200 flood affected families in the above mentioned areas.

The Diocese also established Evacuation Centres (Relief Camps) at Risalpur, Nowshera, and Peshawar

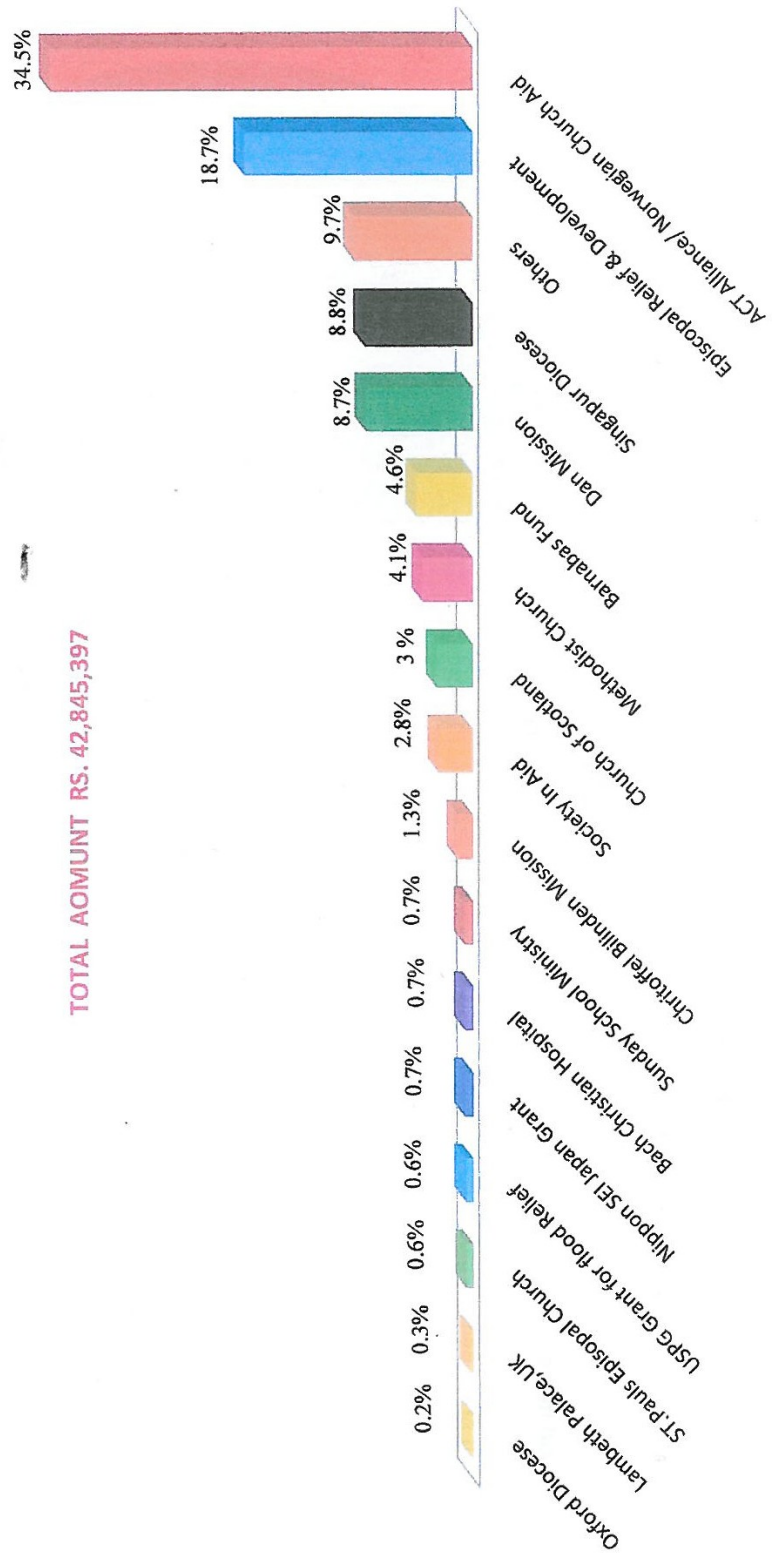

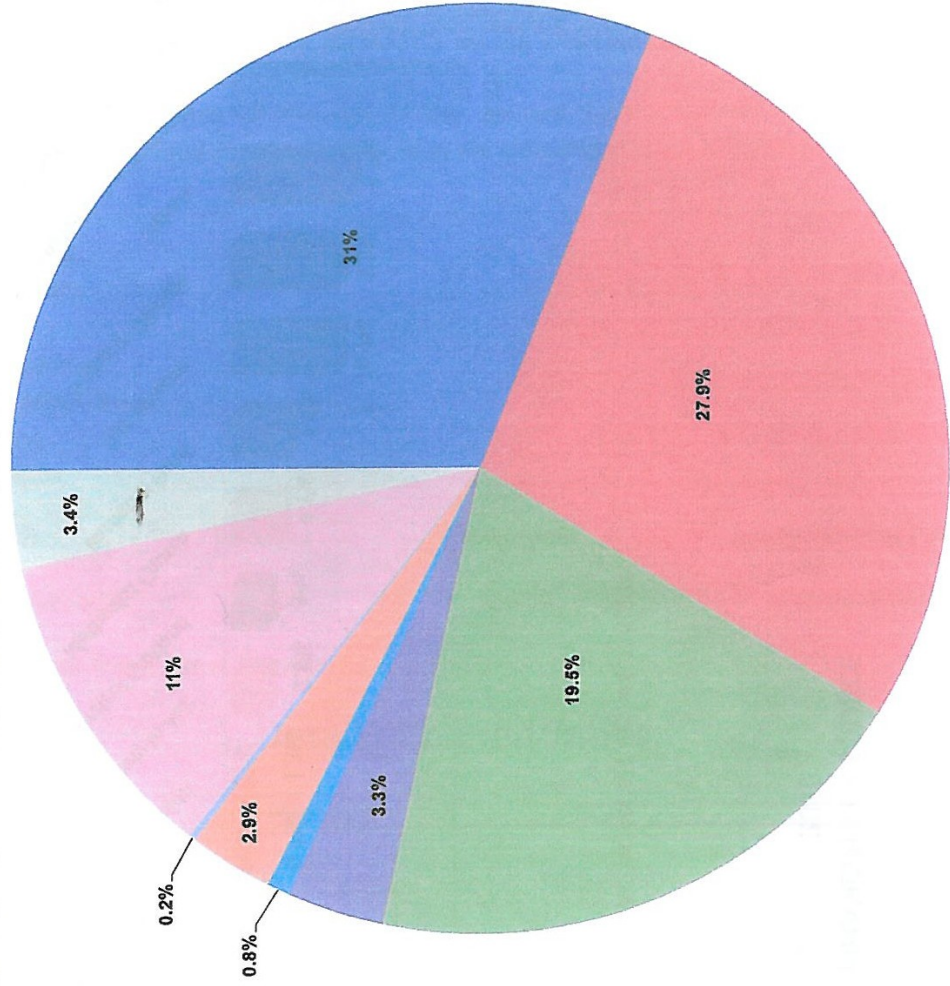

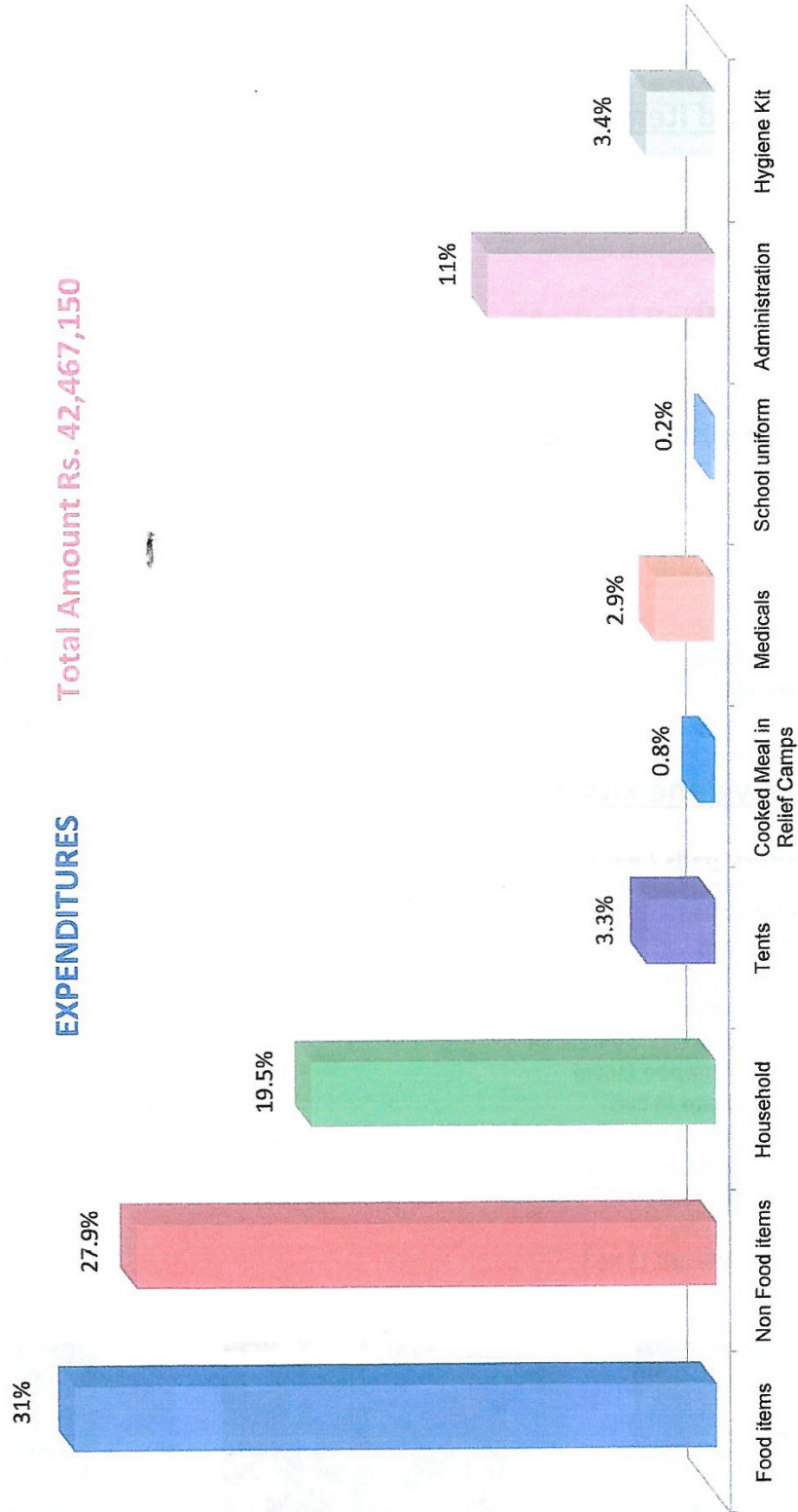
