**III. Description of the emergency situation:** Climate change is affecting Brazil more and more. There is an increased frequency of extreme weather events like "el Nino" and "la Nina" due to global warming.

The occurrence of el Nino has profound socio-economic consequences. Not only because it destroys livelihoods such as subsistence agriculture, but it also destroys their homes and it impacts on health due to water-borne illnesses, lack of appropriate sanitation.

and contaminated drinking water. As always, the poorest people are most affected.

The south of Brazil had experienced severe rains causing flooding, especially in the state of Rio Grande do Sul. The area also experienced a tornado, causing massive destruction, leaving the area in extreme crisis to an already poverty stricken area.

The areas most affected are Canoas, Santa Maria, Itaara, Rosário do Sul, São Gabriel e Pelotas. Approximately 485 families below the poverty line have had their homes destroyed, and the local government does not have enough capacity to meet the needs of so many families. To make matters worse, severe weather is forecasted for the coming weeks.

According to Defesa Civil (similar to our local FEMA), there are 149,276 people affected. 7,125 families fled their homes. 5,779 families were dislocated and found rufuge in the homes of families and friends. There are 1,346 people who are without shelter. **The area of the islands of Porto Alegre is one of the most affected areas.** According to the official numbers there are 12,000 people affected. 1,500 people have been dislocated and from these, 600 people are without shelter.

The Defesa Civil has issued a storm warning as severe rainstorms as well as hail is expected throughout much of the state in the coming days. The 3 dioceses of Area I, (Pelotas, Rio Grande do Sul, and Pelotas) are working with those affected, providing food, clothing, plastic for shelter and protection, and roofing materials. When the water levels begin to subside and people are able to return to their homes or what is left of them, we will have a clearer picture of the work ahead so families can return to safe homes with the minimum provisions for living.
