We call upon the abductors to come to a realisation that they as well as the girls are created in the image of God and have the right to a life of freedom.


We urge the International, Continental and regional security organs to consolidate their rescue efforts.


We trust that the Nigerian government is on the ground on this matter and plead for more efforts to ensure safety and security of all the Nigerians.


May God undertake the big burden on behalf of the girls families remembering His promise when He says “Never will I leave you, Never will I forsake you” (Hebrew 13:5).


