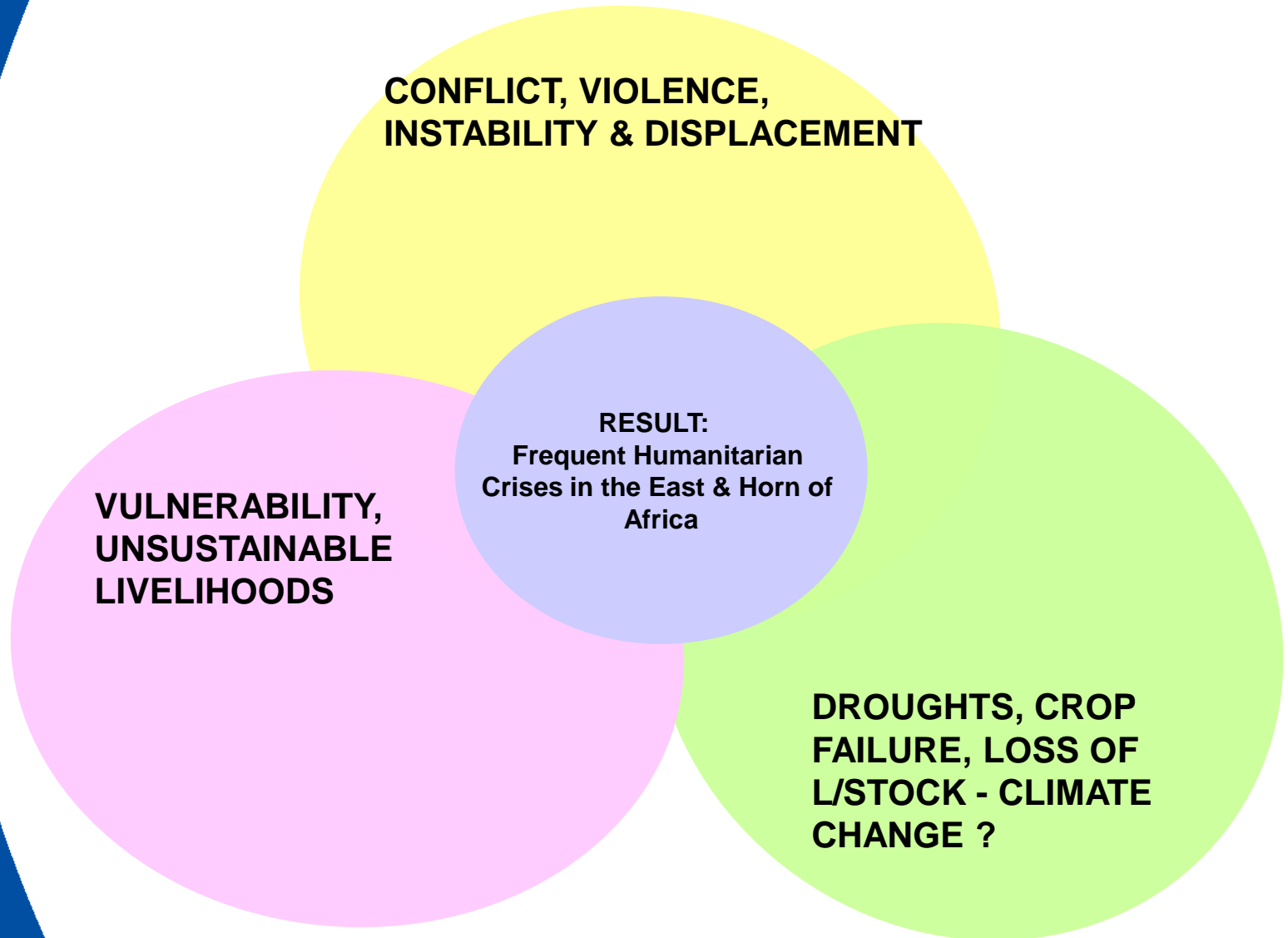

- ☐ Politics of Refugee-Hosts Relations

Short Term Actions

- ☐ Provide humanitarian assistance
 - ☐ financial donations
 - ☐ in-kind material donations
- ☐ Opening up humanitarian space esp. in Somalia
- ☐ Lobby & support Governments of Kenya & Ethiopia to receive & provide a safe haven to refugees

- ☐ Communicate the emergency



Durable Solutions

- ❑ Advocacy for Peace, Justice, Reconciliation & Good Governance
- ❑ Fund programs to achieve MDGs
- ❑ Lobby & support Govts to enact protective legislations
- ❑ Support climate change adaptation
- ❑ Promote irrigation agriculture



Cont'd

- ❑ Fund R&D of sustainable, high productivity crop/livestock farming
- ❑ Lobby & support Govts to implement national food security policies
- ❑ Promote trade (within & between) countries to tap on complementarity
